What About Yarn



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Forget Me Not Infinity Scarf

(vergeet me niet infinity scarf)

Level: Easy +

Terminology: US Terms

Finished Size: Child to Adult

Materials:

- Lion Brand Mandala Sphinx
(or any desired yarn)
- Size G-6 (4.0mm) crochet hook
(or any hook corresponding to your desired yarn)
- Tapestry Needle
- Scissors

Special Stitch:

- Double Crochet Puff Edge (Bead Stitch)

-- Yarn over, insert hook on designated stitch. Yarn over, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook).

Yarn over, pull through two loops (2 loops on hook). Yarn over, pull through two loops to create a Double Crochet (DC) stitch.

Yarn over, insert hook from front to back around the DC stitch, Yarn over, pull up a loop, (3 loops on hook). Yarn over, insert hook from front to back around the DC stitch,

Yarn over, pull up a loop (5 loops on hook). Yarn over, insert hook from front to back around the DC stitch, Yarn over, pull up a loop, (7 loops on hook). Yarn over, pull through all the loops on hook.

Stitches and Abbreviations:

CH (s) - - chain(s)

DC - - double crochet

SK - - skip

ST (s) - - stitch (es)

REP - - repeat

CH SP - - chain space

** - - designates a repeat

Important Notes:

- All turning chains counts as a stitch.
- Foundation Chain is worked in multiples of 5 plus 2.
- You may increase or decrease the width of your scarf by chaining multiples of 5 plus 2 chain.
- You may increase or decrease the length of your scarf by repeating Rows 2, 3 and 4 as many times as you want. Just remember to end with a DC row for joining ends.

Row 1:

CH 40 + 2, DC on 4th CH from hook and in every STs (40 STs). CH 3 + 1, turn.

Row 2:

SK 1st and 2nd STs, work 1 Bead Stitch in 3rd ST, CH 1, SK 1 ST, DC in the next ST.

** DC in the next ST, CH 1, SK 1 ST, work 1 Bead Stitch in next ST, CH 1, SK 1 ST, DC in the next ST ;

REP from ** up to the 3rd CH of the turning CHs from previous row (40 STs). CH 3, turn.

Row 3:

DC in every 1-CH SP and in every Bead Stitch and DC up to the last 1-CH SP, DC on the 3rd CH of the turning CHs from previous row (40 STs). CH 3, turn.

Row 4:

SK 1st DC, DC in the next ST and in every STs up to the 3rd CH of the turning CHs from previous row. (40 STs), CH 3 + 1, turn.

REP Rows 2-3-4 until you reach your desired length of the scarf.

Fasten off. Leave a relatively long tail on the yarn before cutting for seaming.

Twist the scarf in the center from front to back. With a tapestry needle, join both DC ends of the scarf by sewing with woven stitch (or any preferred technique).

Weave in all excess yarns.
