

# Paris-meets-California

## Golf-Club-Covers



### YARN SUGGESTION & NEEDLES

Any Aran or worsted weight will work.

I used GARNSTUDIO DROPS "Paris" in the colors red, ecru and navy blue.

**SIZE:** *One Size – the pattern is easy to adjust to other golfclub sizes*

**MATERIALS:** *~100g of Aran or worsted weight yarn  
4.5 - 5.5mm (US 7 – 9) needles  
Tapestry needle  
Embroidery Yarn*

**GAUGE:** *17 sts x 22 rows = 10 x 10 cm*

**SKILL LEVEL:** *Intermediate*

## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>sc</b>	single crochet
<b>st/s</b>	stitch/es
<b>sl st</b>	slip stitch
<b>ch(s)</b>	chain(s)
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>WS</b>	wrong side

## INSTRUCTIONS

### **Start with the rectangle to create the tube for the shaft of your golf-club:**

The rectangle is worked in rows working back and forth in the back loops of the stitches only. This is creating the nice and flexible ribbing pattern.

#### **Chain 26 stitches.**

**Row 1 (RS):** start with a sc in second st of your chain  
sc in each st until end of row;  
ch1 and turn your work

**Row 2 (WS):** 25 sc in each st across (work in the back loops of your sts only);  
ch1 and turn

Repeat row2 18 times (or until or until you reached the desired width to match your golf-club.)

(For the striped pattern of the US flag I alternated 2 rows of red and 2 rows of white (total of 20 rows with 5 red stripes and 5 white stripes)

Join last row (white) and first row (red) with sl sts.

I joined them on the WS of my work and turned the tube inside out afterwards.

#### **Fasten off.**



Continue with the head cover:

The head cover is crocheted directly to the ribbing tube.  
You work in continuous rounds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.

With color “navy blue” work 30 sl sts in the side stitches of one side of the ribbing tube.  
You will now crochet in the round.

**Rnd 1:** Work in back loops only  
-> You will obtain a nice and stripeline between the head part and the ribbing shaft.

To shape the wider part of the head cover, you will increase 6 st in this rnd as followed:

\*(4 sc, 2sc in next st), repeat \*() 5 times

-> **36** stitches at the end of rnd

**Rnds 2-13:** sc in each st around (**36 sts**)

**Rnd 14:** Decrease 6 st in this rnd as followed:

\*(4 sc, sc next 2st together), repeat \*() 5 times

-> **30** stitches at the end of rnd



**Rnds 15-17:** sc in each st around **(30 sts)**

**Rnd 18:** Decrease another 6 st in this rnd as followed:  
\*(3 sc, sc next 2st together), repeat \*() 5 times  
-> **24** stitches at the end of rnd

**Rnds 19-20:** sc in each st around **(24 sts)**

**Rnd 21:** Decrease 6 st as followed:  
\*(2 sc, sc next 2st together), repeat \*() 5 times  
-> **18** stitches at the end of rnd

**Rnd 22:** Decrease 6 st as followed:  
\*(1 sc, sc next 2st together), repeat \*() 5 times  
-> **12** stitches at the end of rnd

**Rnd 23:** Decrease 6 st as followed:  
\*(sc next 2st together), repeat \*() 5 times  
-> **6** stitches at the end of rnd

Fast off and weave in all ends (the fun part - yeah ;-)

With white yarn embroider stars to your flag.
