

Brisa hat

Vida y punto

We present the Brisa hat, an ideal accessory for your summer holidays. This hat is designed with cellulose raphia-like yarn, so the result is light, fresh and comfortable. The pattern is seamless and the materials do not take up too much space or weigh too much, which makes it a great project to make over the summer and take with you to the beach, a BBQ party or vacation.

Difficulty level / Skills required

Adventurous beginner

The pattern requires the following skills: magic ring, single crochet, increase, double crochet.

Materials

Yarn

Katia 'Marble' (100% viscose cellulose; 180.5 yd/165 m per 1.764 oz/50 gr); 2 balls.

Crochet hook U.S. 7 / 4.5 mm

Notions Stitch markers Yarn needle


Gauge swatch

15 sts/17 rows = 4 inches (10 cm) square in single crochet

Abbreviations

st: stitch ch: chain sc: single crochet inc: increase, 2 sc in the same st sk: skip dc: double crochet rnd: round

Measures



Pattern is designed in 2 sizes, size 1(2), with a slight negative ease so it adapts to your head. Size 1 is for a head circumference of \sim 54-57 cm, and size 2 for a head circumference of \sim 58-61 cm. A: 20.5 (22) in / 52 (56) cm B: 41.7 (43.3) in / 106 (110) cm

Pattern notes

- The hat is worked in a circular way, use a st marker or waste yarn to keep track of the first st of each rnd.
- This fiber is a bit special to crochet, so make sure to crochet a gauge swatch and adapt the crochet hook size to get the final result with the right measurements.

Pattern

Crown

Rnd 1: 6 sc into a magic ring. (6). Rnd 2: 6 inc (12). Rnd 3: (1 inc, 1 sc) 6 times (18). Rnd 4: (2 sc, 1 inc) 6 times (24). Rnd 5: (1 inc, 3 sc) 6 times (24). Rnd 6: (2 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc) 6 times (36). Rnd 7: (1 inc, 5 sc) 6 times (42). Rnd 8: (3 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc) 6 times (48). Rnd 9: (1 inc, 7 sc) 6 times (54). Rnd 10: (4 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc) 6 times (60). Rnd 11: (1 inc, 9 sc) 6 times (66). Rnd 12: (5 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc) 6 times (72). Rnd 13: (1 inc, 11 sc) 6 times (78).

Only size 2: **Rnd 14**: (6 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc) 6 times (84).

Both sizes 1 (2): Repeat 6 times the following round **Rnd:** sc all around (78, 84).

Band

In the following rounds, we will work the decorative trimming of the central part of the hat. You can follow written instructions or the chart on the next page. **Rnd 1**: (sk 2 sts, 5 dc in next st, sk 2 sts, sc in next st) 14 times.

Rnd 2: 3 ch (do count as a dc st), 2 dc in the last sc, (sk 2 sts, sc in next st, sk 2 sts, 5 dc in next st) 13 times, sk 2 sts, sc in next st, sk 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, sc in 3rd initial ch.

Rnd 3: (sk 2 sts, 5 dc in next sc, sk 2 sts, sc in next st) 13 times, sk 2 sts, 5 dc in next st, sk 2 sts, sl st .

Rnd 4: 3 ch (do count as a dc st), (sk 2 sts, 5 dc in next st, sk 2 st, dc in next st) 13 times, sk 2 sts, 5 dc in next st, sk 2 sts, sl st in 3rd initial ch.

Rnd 5: 3 ch (do count as a dc st), 2 dc in same ch, (sk 2 sts, sc in next st, sk 2 sts, 5 dc in next st) 13 times, sk 2 sts, sc in next

st, sk 2 sts, 2 dc in same ch as first 2 dc from this round, sl st in 3rd initial ch. **Rnd 6**: 3 ch (do count as a dc st), 2 dc in same ch, (sk 2 sts, dc in next st, sk 2 sts, 5 dc in next st) 13 times, sk 2 sts, dc in next st, sk 2 sts, 2 dc in same ch as first 2 dc from this round, sc in 3rd initial ch.

Brim

Rnds 1-2: sc.

Rnd 3: (1 inc, 6 sc) 12 times (90, 96). Rnd 4: (1 inc, 11 sc) 8 times (98, 104). Rnd 5: (6sc, 1 inc, 6 sc) 8 times (106, 112). Rnd 6: (13 sc, 1 inc) 8 times (114, 120). Rnd 7: (1 inc, 19 sc) 6 times (120, 126). Rnd 8: (2 sc, 1 inc, 18 sc) 6 times (126, 132). Rnd 9: (4 sc, 1 inc, 17 sc) 6 times (132,

138).

Rnd 10: (6 sc, 1 inc, 16 sc) 6 times (138, 144).

Rnd 11: (8 sc, 1 inc, 15 sc) 6 times (144, 150).

Rnd 12: (10 sc, 1 inc, 14 sc) 6 times (150, 156).

Rnd 13: (12 sc, 1 inc, 13 sc) 6 times (156, 162).

Rnd 14: (14 sc, 1 inc, 12 sc) 6 times (162, 168).

Rnd 15: (16 sc, 1 inc, 11 sc) 6 times (168, 174).


Rnd 16: (18 sc, 1 inc, 10 sc) 6 times (174, 180).

Rnd 17: sc.

Rnd 18: (sc, sk 2 sts, 5 dc in next, sk 2 sts) 30 times, sl st in next sc.

Weave in ends with a yarn needle.
