Faye Dog Snood



Materials

3.5mm crochet hook

Sport weight yarn, approx. 80 (140: 240: 390) (470: 540)m. Samples shown in Scheepjes Stone Washed. If using this yarn you will need 1 (2: 2: 3) (4: 5) balls.

Yarn needle

Difficulty

Easy/beginner

Skills

- Able to follow a written pattern using UK crochet abbreviations
- Working in rows
- Basic stitches (ch, dc, htr)

Stitch terms:

- Ch chain stitch
- Dc double crochet
- Htr half treble crochet
- RS right side
- WS wrong side
- BLO back loop only



Gauge

10cm = 19 stitches and 18 rows in the same stitch pattern as the snood.

Sizing

XS (S: M: L) (XL: XXL) designed to have between 2-6" of positive ease for an oversized appearance and to ensure that it can go over collars. The length also allows for the snood to be folded into a roll neck, or to go over your dog's ears. If your dog's neck measurement is between sizes, use the smaller

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size for a more fitted look. If you wish to adapt the length, add/remove to the original starting chain. If you wish to adapt the circumference, add/remove rows.

Pattern Notes

Starting/turning chains do not count as stitches and are not included in the stitch count.

This snood is constructed sideways – your starting chain will run vertically once the snood is finished. The snood is worked in one panel which is sewn together at the end to form a tube.

Snood Pattern

To start, ch32 (42: 56: 78) (78: 78).

R1: (WS) Htr in 3rd st from hook. Htr across, ch1, turn. [30 (40: 54: 76) (76: 76)]

R2: (RS) Dc in BLO across. Ch2, turn. [30 (40: 54: 76) (76: 76)]

R3: (WS) Htr across, ch1, turn. [30 (40: 54: 76) (76: 76)]

Repeat R2 and R3 in sequence until you have completed R51 (63: 81: 97) (119: 137), or until you have reached your desired circumference (though make sure your last row is an odd number). Ch1, turn, do not fasten off your last stitch.

Due to the stitch pattern this piece may appear to slant, and so I would suggest blocking your work.

Construction

You may join with any stitch you wish. If you wish to maintain the texture, sl st through both the last row and the initial chain sequence to join the snood into a tube. Fasten off and weave in all ends.
